 for East Timor and a fundraising cake stall for first Sunday in June.
- Parish Website: This is fairly stable now after we had an issue with exceeding the bandwidth allocated to our level of funding. Doug corrected this but if we run into this situation again, Doug is looking to upgrade to the next band width - only an extra \$50-\$60 p.a.No action needed as yet and Doug will monitor. Doug is keen to get contribution from other groups for the website.

- Prison Ministry continues, and Matt expects to receive his "green card" which will allow unrestricted visits to the prison without supervision.
- Centrecare. We need to contact Paul Fogarty for an update before he retires. The annual appeal is on this weekend.
